Proposed changes to Regulations 22 and 5

Dear Chairman Burnett,

In light of the recently proposed changes to Regulations 22 and 5, IGT would like to put forth additional modifications to further streamline the account registration process, particularly for those patrons who register for account based wagering in person. Currently, both the regulations for different types of gaming, and the technologies that support them, are based on wholly separate systems. Patrons are required to visit multiple data collection points, interface with multiple people and provide repetitive information. Today's technology allows Nevada operators to take advantage of synergies and efficiencies among the different types of gaming, using comprehensive systems or system interfaces. IGT's aim is to improve the overall patron and operator experience for opening and using wagering accounts, while fully maintaining a high degree of integrity.

IGT proposes modifications to Regulations 22 and 5, as summarized below:

- To allow the Chairman of the Nevada Gaming Control Board to authorize persons other than employees of the book to perform the functions required to establish a wagering account by a customer in person. This would facilitate employees from other areas of a Casino establishment (such as the Cashier or Player's Club) also being able to open wagering accounts within the licensee's property.
- To allow a mobile gaming account which is created under Regulation 5 or a sports wagering account created under regulation 22 to be used as a basis to create an account for the other activity with the same licensee/operator, subject to the relevant terms and conditions of each service having been accepted by the player, which can be done electronically or in person.
- To harmonize the regulations regarding personal data by removing the requirement to record gender and social security number when the account is created
