Re: CG Technology Proposed Amendments to Regulation 5.220 and Proposed Adoption of New Regulation 5.221 (Mobile Gaming)


Dear Chairman Burnett and Members of the Board:

Silverton Casino, LLC, a licensed Nevada casino, supports the adoption of CG Technology's proposed amendment to Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 5.220 and the proposed adoption of new Regulation 5.221 (the "Mobile Gaming Amendments"), both of which are under consideration by the Nevada Gaming Control Board (the "Board"). We have followed the efforts of CG Technology and ask for favorable action.

Both interactive gaming and mobile gaming are existing technologies approved by the State Gaming Control Board and Commission. Allowing for these Mobile Gaming Amendments will provide procedures to register for a mobile gaming account in person or remotely; these procedures will track the registration process for interactive gaming accounts set forth in Regulation 5A.110. The Mobile Gaming Amendments will enable casino operators and mobile gaming system operators to engage patrons for commercial purposes and harmonize the standards between interactive gaming and mobile gaming. We believe this, in turn, will drive play, thereby improving handle. With the Mobile Gaming Amendments, we may enhance the player experience and further Nevada's leadership of the global gaming industry, all while maintaining the highest standards of integrity.

On behalf of Silverton Casino, LLC, we ask the Board to endorse the Mobile Gaming Amendments and look forward to the Board conducting industry workshops on this matter. We appreciate continuing efforts to make the Nevada regulatory climate one where the gaming industry may flourish and that instills confidence in the gaming public.
