Applications must be submitted 30 days prior to the commencement of any charitable bingo activity, including advertising. Organizations are encouraged to file applications earlier than the required 30 days. Under Nevada Revised Statute 463:

- ◆ Qualified organizations are required to correct and submit any additional information necessary to maintain a correct and complete application with the Board. Approval of a qualified organization is suspended during the period in which any information becomes inaccurate or incomplete.
- ◆ Qualified organizations may not compensate any person for the prizes and supplies used in the operation of charitable bingo in the amount that exceeds their market value.
- ◆ Qualified organizations may not provide compensation to any person who is not a regular employee of the organization, or provide additional compensation to any regular employee for services in organizing or operation charitable bingo.
- ◆ Qualified organizations approved by the Chairman must submit annual financial reports concerning their activities.
- ◆ Registration and approval are revocable privileges.
- ◆ The net proceeds may only be expended for the benefit of charitable or nonprofit activities in Nevada.
