INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS REQUESTING ENROLLMENT AS AN AGENT PURSUANT TO NGC REGULATION 10

AN APPLICANT FOR ENROLLEMENT AS AN AGENT IS SEEKING THE GRANTING OF A PRIVILEGE, AND THE BURDEN OF PROVING HIS/HER QUALIFICATIONS TO RECEIVE SUCH AN APPROVAL IS AT ALL TIMES ON THE APPLICANT. AN APPLICANT MUST ACCEPT ANY RISK OF ADVERSE PUBLIC NOTICE, EMBARRASSMENT, CRITICISM, OR OTHER ACTION, OR FINANCIAL LOSS WHICH MAY RESULT FROM ACTION WITH RESPECT TO AN APPLICATION, AND EXPRESSLY WAIVES ANY CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AS A RESULT THEREOF.

NGC Regulation 10.010 Eligibility to Practice.

No person shall be eligible to practice before the commission or the board unless such person is enrolled in accordance with these regulations, except that any individual may appear, without enrollment, on his own behalf or on behalf of a member of his immediate family, if such appearance is without compensation; and a member of a partnership, an officer of a corporation, or an authorized regular employee of an individual, partnership, corporation, or other business entity may likewise appear without enrollment in any matter relating to such individual or business entity.

1. Form 19: Enrollment as an Agent
2. Letter of Recommendation from Enrolled Person (NGC Regulation 10.040)
3. Curriculum Vitae which includes your work experience and education.
4. Form 17: Release and Indemnity of All Claims – If the applicant is married the applicant's spouse must also sign this form.
5. Form 18: Request to Release Information - If the applicant is married the applicant's spouse must also sign this form.
