

NEVADA GAMING CONTROL BOARD

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS REQUESTING A PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF A LOCATION'S SUITABILITY FOR THE CONDUCT OF GAMING

A request for preliminary determination of a location's suitability is made pursuant to NGC Regulation 4.105, and is an extraordinary remedy that will be considered by the Board and Commission only in unusual circumstances.

The following items must be submitted to the Nevada Gaming Control Board when applying for a determination. All forms can be found on our website at gaming.nv.gov:

1. Form 14, Application for Approval from Nevada Gaming Authorities.
2. A site plan giving information on the business address or location, including proximity to schools, churches, and playgrounds.
3. Approximate size and cost of the construction.
4. Source of funds.
5. Names, dates of birth, and social security numbers of all officers, directors, stockholders, and/or partners.
6. A breakdown of slot machines and games to be operated.
7. A statement addressing the following:
 - (a) Suitability of the proposed site pursuant to NGC Regulation 3.010;
 - (b) Circumstances justifying the preliminary determination of suitability;
 - (c) Certification that notice of this application was made to the city or county having jurisdiction over the location;
 - (d) Local zoning ordinances.
8. A check or money order in the amount of \$500 to cover the application fee. Checks are to be made payable to the Nevada Gaming Control Board. The Board may require payment of investigative fees and costs as determined by the Board.
