Win Revenue Summary – March 2006

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$1,062,939,809 for the month of March 2006. This amounts to a 3.04% increase compared to March 2005, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,031,533,684. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2005 through March 31, 2006), gaming win has increased 12.48%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of April 2006

The State collected \$92,767,201 in percentage fees during the month of April 2006, based upon the taxable revenues generated in March 2006. This represents a 4.67% (or \$4,137,200) increase compared to the prior year’s April, when percentage fee collections were \$88,630,001.
