Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – January 2009

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$908,573,953 for the month of January 2009. This amounts to a 14.62% decrease compared to January 2008, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,064,119,846. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2008 through January 31, 2009), gaming win has decreased 14.05%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of February 2009

The State collected \$47,023,386 in percentage fees during the month of February 2009, based upon the taxable revenues generated in January 2009. This represents a 42.31% (or \$34,482,685) decrease compared to the prior year's February, when percentage fee collections were \$81,506,071.
