CONSIDERATION AND/OR ADOPTION OF: Proposed amendments to **NGC REGULATION 3.100, EMPLOYEE REPORT; AND REPEAL OF: NGC REGULATION 22.035, REGISTRATION OF EMPLOYEES:** To amend regulation 3.100(c) to add race book and sports pool to the definition of “qualifying employee” requiring nonrestricted licensees to report key employees in race books and sports pools semi-annually and to repeal regulation 22.035 which provides that any individual who fulfills the function of race book or sports pool manager, race book or sports pool supervisor, manager or supervisor for an operator of a call center or who determines race book or sports pool betting odds, point spreads or betting lines must register with the GCB; and to take such additional action as may be necessary to effectuate these stated purposes.
