Re: Interstate Wide Area Progressives

Dear Chairman Bernhard:

We understand the Nevada Gaming Commission will consider on November 21, 2013, adopting amendments to Regulations 5 and 14 to allow wide area progressive jackpots among different gaming jurisdictions. Our client, Gaming Arts, LLC, asks the Commission to act favorably on these proposed rule changes.

Allowing new progressive prizes can improve player excitement in slot machines and other linked games, make our State more competitive with expansion in other markets, and provide an entirely new way to promote visits to Nevada casino properties. The inclusion of "other games" within Section 14.010(15)(c), will permit companies like Gaming Arts to offer interstate progressive prizes for linked Keno games.

We encourage the Commission to use its broad regulatory oversight to permit multi-jurisdictional progressive prize systems. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you would like to discuss this further.
