**Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections**

**Win Revenue Summary – February 2014**

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$926,083,897 for the month of February 2014. This amounts to a 13.71% decrease compared to February 2013, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,073,261,160. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2013 through February 28, 2014), gaming win has increased 0.92%.

**Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of March 2014**

The State collected \$58,907,549 in percentage fees during the month of March 2014\*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in February 2014. This represents a 4.63% (or \$2,861,502) decrease compared to the prior year's March, when percentage fee collections were \$61,769,051.
