

Texas Peek Hold'em

Rules of Play

Texas Peek Hold'em is a seven card poker game played using a standard deck of 52 cards. Winning hands are determined by the best Five (5) cards consisting of the community cards and the player's hole cards. Bonus payouts are as per the bonus pay tables.

1. To begin, all players make a Blind Wager before any cards are dealt. This qualifies them for a bonus which plays against the Blind Wager pay table.
2. The dealer will burn a card and deal himself two (2) hole cards; The dealer will then turn over one (1) of his hole cards for all players to view.
3. After viewing the dealers (1) hole card players may place a "Peek Wager" or fold. If a player folds, his Blind Wager is still in action.
4. The dealer will then burn a card and deal all remaining players their (2) two hole cards.
5. After players view their two (2) hole cards, players will decide to fold or make a Raise Wager 2X or 4X the amount of their Peek Wager. If a player folds, his Peek Wager is lost but his Blind Wager is still in action.
6. The dealer will then burn a card and then deal the flop (reveal) 3 community cards face up and place them on the board (layout) for all to view.
7. Players must now place the "I'm In" Wager or surrender. If the I'm In Wager is made it must be equal to their original Peek Wager. If a player elects to surrender, the player will lose his original Peek Wager and keep half of his Raise Wager.
8. The dealer will now turn over his second hole card allowing all players to view both of his cards.
9. Then the dealer will burn a card and deal the last two (2) community cards and place them on the board face up.
10. The dealer will set his five card poker hand and compare his hand to the player's best five card poker hand. If the player wins his overall hand, he is paid even money on both the Peek Wager and the Raise Wager. If the dealer wins his overall hand, the player loses both the Peek Wager and the Raise Wager. If the player's hand and the dealer's hand tie, the Peek Wager and the Raise Wager are a push.

I'm In Wager – Only those players that have completed all wagers qualify for this payout. The "I'm In" Wager is based on the player's best five card poker hand and pays per the I'm In Bonus pay table. If a player loses his hand to the dealer and has less than a flush, he will lose this wager. If a Player's hand is less than a flush but his hand beats the dealer's hand, this wager will push. If the players and the Dealers hand pushes the player will lose this wager.

"Blind Wager" - The Blind Wager bonus is based on the dealer's 2 hole cards and pays as per the Blind Wager pay table.
