Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – October 2015

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$887,577,506 for the month of October 2015. This amounts to a 2.85% decrease compared to October 2014, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$913,642,221. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2015 through October 31, 2015), gaming win has decreased 0.93%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of November 2015

The State collected \$52,293,910 in percentage fees during the month of November 2015*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in October 2015. This represents a 21.72% (or \$14,511,840) decrease compared to the prior year's November, when percentage fee collections were \$66,805,750.
