Approval to Offer Wagers on the 2017 League of Legends World Championship

On July 26, 2017, the Nevada Gaming Control Board granted Regulation 22.120 approval to offer wagers on the 2017 League of Legends World Championship eSports competition to be held at multiple venues in China from September 23, 2017, through November 4, 2017. Approval is granted to accept wagers on single matchups and the acceptance of futures wagers for the final winner. The 2017 League of Legends World Championship approval is subject to the following conditions:

- Licensed books electing to offer these wagers must provide the Enforcement Division with notification of terms via email at ops@gcb.nv.gov.
- Acceptance of wagers for this eSports competition must cease five minutes prior to the start of each scheduled event.
- The official source of results shall be www.lolesports.com/en_US/worlds.
- All audit procedures detailed in Industry Letter 2011-48 must be adhered to.
- The setting of odds is at the discretion of the book; rules governing this wager shall be available to the public.
- Deviations from, or additions to the contingencies listed above, will require a separate application and approval.
