Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – March 2018

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$1,024,316,755 for the month of March 2018. This amounts to a 3.37% increase compared to March 2017, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$990,969,814. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018), gaming win has increased 2.44%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of April 2018

The State collected \$75,736,217 in percentage fees during the month of April 2018*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in March 2018. This represents a 5.71% (or \$4,585,919) decrease compared to the prior year's April, when percentage fee collections were \$80,322,136.
