not intend to object to CGT's proposed Stipulated Order;

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THEREFORE, the parties hereby stipulate that the Commission may consider any
documents, information, and evidence transmitted to the Commission to assist in its
27 consideration of Respondents' Proposed Stipulated Order.

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1 The BOARD and Respondents have exchanged certain documents relevant to this
 2 matter that are deemed confidential and/or privileged pursuant to NRS chapter 463. By
 3 November 5, 2018, Respondents shall transmit a full and complete set of the exchanged
 4 documents to the Commission's counsel for filing under seal and all such documents shall
 5 retain all confidentiality and privileges in accordance with Nevada Law. Such documents
 6 include:

- 7 1. Documents in support of the allegations contained in the Complaint in this
- 8 matter;
- 9 2. Documents representing Respondents' estimated value of CSB; and
- 10 3. Documents representing the costs associated with transitioning to and
- 11 implementing a replacement for CSB.


12 If the Stipulated Order is not accepted by the Commission, nothing herein shall be

 15 Commission.


