SUBJECT: 2018-05R: NOTICE OF HEARING FOR CONSIDERATION OF ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATIONS 5, 5A, 22, 26B & 26C REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LICENSEE HIRE AND TERMINATION REPORTING; WAGERING ACCOUNT CREATION REQUIREMENTS; INFORMATION DISSEMINATION; AUTHORIZED PLAYER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS; SUSPICIOUS WAGER REPORTS; REGULATION OF OFF-TRACK PARI-MUTUEL HORSE RACE ACCOUNT WAGERING; OTHER EVENTS; AND REGULATION OF RACE BOOKS AND SPORTS POOLS.

The Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering adoption, amendment or repeal of the regulation(s) stated below.

2018-05R: ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 5 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DEFINED TERMS; LICENSEE HIRE AND TERMINATION REPORTING; ACCOUNT WAGERING INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS; AND DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION.

PURPOSE: To modify requirements for licensee hire and termination reporting; to modify the definition of wagering accounts; to change the requirement that a licensee obtain, record, and verify a patron's full social security number for creation of a wagering account; to allow remote sign up and verification for wagering accounts; to allow dissemination of certain information to affiliates and to licensees who lease space to a satellite book; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

2018-05R: ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 5A REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, REGISTRATION OF AN AUTHORIZED PLAYER; AND SUSPICIOUS WAGER REPORTING.

PURPOSE: To change the requirement that an individual must provide the individual's full social security number to be registered as an authorized player; to modify suspicious wager reporting to include suspicious transactions; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

2018-05R: ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 22 REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, VARIOUS AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATION AND OPERATION OF RACE BOOKS AND SPORTS POOLS.

PURPOSE: To add definitions for "amateur sport or athletic event," "governing body," "other event," "professional sport or athletic event," and "virtual event;" to modify definitions for "call center system," "communications technology," "operator of a call center," and "sports pool;" to move the definition of "collegiate sport or athletic event;" to modify the approval requirements of call centers; to modify reserve requirements; to adjust the period in which a book must honor winning betting tickets; to adjust parlay card wager requirements; to allow unilateral rescission of wagers under certain circumstances; to move and modify requirements regarding other events; to create a list of sanctioning organizations which may sanction other events for the purposes of books accepting wagers on such other events; to set out how organizations are added and removed from the list of sanctioning organizations; to create a list of pre-approved other events; to set out how other events are added and removed from the list of pre-approved other events; to set out an appeal process for removal from the list of pre-approved other events; to set out a list of permitted wagers; to modify the list of prohibited wagers; to set out a process by which wagers on athletic sporting events become prohibited if the Chair makes certain findings regarding the governing body of such events; to delete the definition of "professional team;" to adjust the communications technology approval, notice, and consent requirements; to authorize out-of-state sports, nonpari-mutuel, and other event wagers if such wagers are legal under the other state's law and federal law; to modify marketing plan approvals; to update cross-references; to delete the requirement that pari-mutuel horse race wagers require a wagering account separate from other types of wagering accounts; to correct which

executed agreements concerning global risk management must be provided to the Chair; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

2018-05R: ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 26B REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DEFINED TERMS.

PURPOSE: To updated the definition of “other event” in line with the proposed language in Regulation 22; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes

For Possible Action

2018-05R: ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS AMENDMENTS TO NEVADA GAMING COMMISSION REGULATION 26C REGARDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, DEFINED TERMS; CALL CENTERS; RESERVE REQUIREMENTS; AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY.

PURPOSE: To remove the conflict between the regulatory and statutory definitions of “communications technology;” to make it clear a call center system includes sports wagering applications; to correct the definition of “operator of a call center;” to modify the approval requirements of call centers; to modify reserve requirements; to adjust the communications technology approval, notice, and consent requirements; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

The proposed regulation changes will be considered by the NGC in accordance with the provisions of NRS 463.145, which provides that on the date and at the time and place designated, any interested person, or their duly authorized representative, or both, shall be afforded the opportunity to present statements, arguments or contentions in writing, with or without the opportunity to present the same orally.

These items will be heard by the NGC at the January 24, 2019 meeting, and may be continued and heard at subsequent meetings of the NGC as required to effectuate the above-stated purposes.
