Win Revenue Summary – April 2007

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$1,053,250,679 for the month of April 2007. This amounts to a 6.39% increase compared to April 2006, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$989,965,466. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2006 through April 30, 2007), gaming win has increased 4.82%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of May 2007

The State collected \$56,383,045 in percentage fees during the month of May 2007, based upon the taxable revenues generated in April 2007. This represents a 6.63% (or \$3,507,286) increase compared to the prior year's May, when percentage fee collections were \$52,875,759.
