Under Nevada Revised Statute 463:

- ◆ Qualified organizations are required to correct and submit any additional information necessary to maintain a correct and complete application with the Board. Approval of a qualified organization is suspended during the period in which any information becomes inaccurate or incomplete.
- ◆ Qualified organizations may not compensate any person for the prizes and supplies used in the operation of Charitable Bingo in the amount that exceeds their market value.
- ◆ Qualified organizations may not provide compensation to any person who is not a regular employee of the organization, or provide additional compensation to any regular employee for services in organizing or operation Charitable Bingo.
- ◆ Qualified organizations approved by the Chair of the Nevada Gaming Control Board must submit annual financial reports concerning their activities.
- ◆ Registration and approval are revocable privileges.
- ◆ The net proceeds may only be expended for the benefit of charitable or nonprofit activities in Nevada.
