**APPLICATIONS FOR FINDINGS OF
SUITABILTIY AS A LANDLORD**

THIS MATTER having come on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board (BOARD) on August 4, 2021, in Las Vegas, Nevada, upon the consideration of the finding of suitability of FROM THE ASHES LLC, dba SLIDIN' CLYDE'S TAVERN (ASHES) (Business Operator/Landlord), SADIE KATHRYN SWAIM (SWAIM) (Member/Manager), and WILLIAM ALLEN SCOTT (SCOTT) (Manager) as landlords;

AND WHEREAS the Nevada Gaming Commission (Commission) having called forward ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT for findings of suitability as landlords on May 20, 2021, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 463.162(5)(a), in response to multiple alleged violations of the Nevada Governor's Emergency Directives relating to the COVID-19 pandemic;

1 AND WHEREAS ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT were notified, via certified mail, that
2 the Commission had called them forward and that they had until June 21, 2021 to file the
3 required applications for findings of suitability (Required Applications) pursuant to NRS
4 463.162(6);

5 AND WHEREAS if a person called forward pursuant to NRS 463.162(5)(a) fails to
6 submit the required application with the Commission within 30 days of being instructed to
7 do so, the Commission has the authority, pursuant to NRS 463.162(6), to pursue any
8 remedy or combination of remedies provided in NRS Chapter 463, including, but not limited
9 to, the denial of the required application and/or a finding of unsuitability;

10 AND WHEREAS ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT failed to submit the Required
11 Applications on or before the June 21, 2021 deadline, or prior to the conclusion of the
12 August 4, 2021 hearing on this matter before the BOARD;

13 AND WHEREAS THE BOARD, having received and reviewed all information
14 relative thereto, and ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT having failed to appear before the
15 BOARD after having notice and opportunity to appear;

16 AND WHEREAS THE BOARD, having determined that ASHES, SWAIM, and
17 SCOTT each failed to satisfy the burdens of proving their qualifications for finding of
18 suitability as landlords as required in NRS 463.170(1). Specifically, the BOARD having
19 found that ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT each failed to meet the requirements of
20 NRS 463.170(2)(a) by failing to prove they are persons of good character, honesty, and
21 integrity. Consequently, good cause appearing:

22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, upon unanimous vote, that a recommendation of denial
23 of ASHES', SWAIM'S, and SCOTT'S applications be, and hereby is, issued to the
24 Commission pursuant to NRS 463.1405(3) and 463.210(3), said recommendation being
25 based upon NRS 463.0129 and NRS 463.170;

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, upon unanimous vote, that a recommendation of the
27 finding that ASHES, SWAIM, and SCOTT, individually and collectively, are unsuitable to
28 participate, financially or otherwise, in the gaming industry in the State of Nevada be, and

1 hereby is, issued to the Commission pursuant to NRS 463.1405(3) and 463.210(3), said
2 recommendation being based upon NRS 463.0129 and NRS 463.170.


