11 On April 4, 2022, the parties in the above-captioned case and non-party Stadium
12 Technology Group, LLC (Stadium Technology) met and conferred with the Chair of the
13 Nevada Gaming Commission (NGC or Commission) to discuss outstanding discovery and
14 procedural matters, including the Respondents' Subpoena Duces Tecum and Deposition
15 Subpoena directed to Stadium Technology. During the meet and confer, counsel for
16 Respondents moved to withdraw both subpoenas. Also, at the request of the Commission
17 Chair, counsel for Stadium Technology voluntarily agreed to a *limited* search for the
18 documents requested in paragraphs 4, and 6-12 of the Subpoena Duces Tecum using the
19 following definitions:

20 "Past Post Wagers" only refer to the wagers upon events whose outcomes had already
21 been determined that occurred in the June 2018, January 2019, March 2019 and January
22 2022 incidents, as defined in the Subpoena Duces Tecum and set forth in the Complaint in
23 the above-captioned case.

24 "Technology" only refers to the software and hardware that is or was developed,
25 maintained, integrated, sold, and/or licensed by Stadium Technology that specifically
26 relates to and/or is at issue in the June 2018, January 2019, March 2019 and January 2022
27 incidents, as defined in the Subpoena Duces Tecum and set forth in the Complaint in the
28 above-captioned case.

1 Pursuant to NGC Regulations 2.020(1), 7.050, 7.070(5) and 7.130, the Commission
2 Chair is delegated the authority to issue rulings on discovery issues and other procedural
3 or prehearing matters that are not dispositive of the case. Specifically, NGC Regulation
4 7.070(5) authorizes the Chair to enter an order at any time on any matter delegated to the
5 Chair.

6 **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT** Respondents' Subpoena Duces
7 Tecum and Deposition Subpoena are WITHDRAWN without prejudice.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** the parties and non-party Stadium
9 Technology meet and confer to discuss Stadium Technology's production of any responsive
10 documents that result from the limited search as set forth above.

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** following the meet and confer with Stadium
12 Technology, the parties meet and confer to determine whether an extension of the deadlines
13 set forth in the current Stipulated Discovery Plan and Scheduling Order is warranted, and
14 if so, file an amended written stipulation proposing a new scheduling order for the
15 Commission Chair's consideration.

16 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT** any party, including non-party Stadium
17 Technology, shall file a motion in accordance with NGC Regulation 7.200 requesting a meet
18 and confer with the Commission Chair to address discovery disputes, only after making
19 every effort to resolve the dispute as required by NGC Regulation 7.130.
