SECOND REVISED ORDER

7 THIS MATTER came on for hearing before the Nevada Gaming Control Board (Board)  
8 on Wednesday, July 13, 2022, for the purpose of determining appointments to the Esports  
9 Technical Advisory Committee (Committee). Pursuant to NRS 463.830, the Board shall  
10 appoint a Committee consisting of professionals from the Esports industry. The Board  
11 having considered all information relevant thereto, including the public policy of this state  
12 concerning gaming, finds that there is good cause for appointment of certain individuals to  
13 the Committee pursuant to NRS 463.830. Therefore, pursuant to the unanimous vote of  
14 the Board;

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 16 1. The Revised Order concerning the Committee dated February 24, 2022, is hereby  
17 revised and restated, in its entirety, by this Revised Order.
- 18 2. The following eight individuals are hereby appointed to the Committee:
- 19 1. Brett Abarbanel, Ph.D.
  - 20 2. Paul Hamilton. Mr. Hamilton is an Esports industry participant and satisfies  
21 NRS 463.830(2)(c).
  - 22 3. Seth Schorr. Mr. Schorr is an Esports industry host and satisfies NRS  
23 463.830(2)(b).
  - 24 4. Lovell Walker.
  - 25 5. Jud Hannigan. Mr. Hannigan is an Esports industry broadcaster and  
26 satisfies NRS 463.830(2)(d).

1           6. Robert D. Forbes. Mr. Forbes is an Esports industry game publisher and  
2           satisfies NRS 463.830(2)(a).

3           7. Brandon Snow.

4           8. Che Chou.

5 3. Paul Hamilton shall serve as Chair of the Committee.

6 4. Unless terminated by the Board earlier, the appointment of each member of the  
7 Committee appointed herein shall expire at midnight on the last day of the November  
8 2024 Nevada Gaming Control Board Meeting.

9 5. Each member of the Committee shall serve without compensation.

10 6. A majority of the members constitutes a quorum of the Committee, and a majority of  
11 the members present at any meeting determines the action of the Committee.

12 7. The Committee shall hold meetings no more than once per calendar quarter, except as  
13 otherwise approved by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee, to formulate and  
14 provide recommendations to the Board on any guidelines and parameters that may be  
15 necessary to ensure the integrity of Esports when wagers are placed on such  
16 competitions.

17 8. The Committee may use administrative support provided by the Board and approved  
18 by the Board Chair or the Board Chair's Designee.

19 9. The Committee must comply with all federal, state, and local laws and regulations,  
20 specifically including, without limitation, the Nevada Open Meeting Law.

21 10. In carrying out its duties, the Committee may not request or require the disclosure of  
22 any proprietary information, intellectual property, or trade secret.


