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Approval to Offer Wagers on 2011 World Series of Poker Propositions

On July 6, 2011, the Gaming Control Board granted approval to offer wagers on the 2011 World Series of Poker pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 22.120. Approval is granted for all licensed books to post and accept wagers on the following propositions:

Player from which group will last the longest?

(Two groups of 13 players were approved.)

Group 1 (House Odds)

Group 2 (House Odds)

At least 1 player from either field must finish in the money for action.

Will at least one of these (3) players finish in the money?

(A group of three players was approved.)

Yes (House Odds)

No (House Odds)

At least two players must start for action.

Will a woman finish in the top 40?

Yes (House Odds)

No (House Odds)

Will at least one of these seven men last longer than all women?

(A group of seven players was approved.)

Yes (House Odds)

No (House Odds)

At least five of the listed men must start for action.

The 1st place finisher will be born before a specific date.

(Specific date was provided.)

Yes (House Odds)

No (House Odds)

These propositions have been approved pursuant to Regulation 22.120 and are available to any licensed book pursuant to the conditions and limitations indicated herein. The setting of all odds is at the discretion of the book, and rules governing these wagers shall be made available to the public. **Any additional wagers which deviate from those listed above will require a separate submission and approval.** Licensed books electing to offer these wagers must provide the Enforcement Division with notification of terms via email at ops@gcb.nv.gov.
