Win Revenue Summary – September 2006

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$984,969,514 for the month of September 2006. This amounts to a 2.66% decrease compared to September 2005, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,011,894,275. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2006 through September 30, 2006), gaming win has increased 4.34%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of October 2006

The State collected \$58,771,464 in percentage fees during the month of October 2006, based upon the taxable revenues generated in September 2006. This represents a 13.65% (or \$9,292,781) decrease compared to the prior year's October, when percentage fee collections were \$68,064,245.
