## **REGULATION(S)**

6. **HEARING ON:** Proposed amendments to **NGC 14: “MANUFACTURERS, DISTRIBUTORS, OPERATORS OF INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEMS, GAMING DEVICES, NEW GAMES, INTER-CASINO LINKED SYSTEMS, ON-LINE SLOT METERING SYSTEMS, CASHLESS WAGERING SYSTEMS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT.”** To provide definitions for the terms “Assume responsibility”, “Control program”, “Distribution”, “Distribute”, “Game variation”, “Independent Contractor”, and “Manufacture” as used in NGC Regulation 14; to modify definitions for the terms “Distributor”, “Distributor of associated equipment”, “Manufacturer”, “Manufacturer of associated equipment”, and “Modification” as used in NGC Regulation 14; to add regulation setting the requirements to qualify as an independent contractor; to add regulation establishing the registration requirements for an independent contractor; to add regulation establishing the reporting requirements of an independent contractor; to add regulation establishing required provisions of the agreement between the licensed manufacturer and the independent contractor; to add regulation stating the licensed manufacturer’s responsibilities for independent contractors; to change what information must be provided to the State Gaming Control Board (Board) as part of the application for approval of gaming devices and the operation of new inter-casino linked systems; to modify the minimum standards for gaming devices connected to a common payoff schedule; to add regulation allowing the Board’s Chairman to publish technical standards for approval of other associated equipment; to remove the sixty (60) day minimum requirement for testing of a new gaming device or new inter-casino linked system at a licensed gaming establishment; to add regulation stating the requirements for the installation of a system based game and a system supported game; to amend regulation to clarify that applications for approval to modify a gaming device or inter-casino linked system must be made by a manufacturer; to amend regulation to require that certain documentation relating to independent contractors be provided as part of the application for approval of a new gaming device if applicable; to add Regulation allowing the Board Chairman to waive certain requirements relating to the marking, registration, and distribution of gaming devices; to add regulation that adds the requirement that applications for approval of promotional devices include a description of how the device complies with all applicable statutes, regulations, and technical standards; to eliminate the requirement that the Board Chairman grant or deny an application for approval of a promotional device within thirty (30) days of the receipt of a complete application; to amend regulations to provide requirements for the approval of game variations; to amend regulations to require an applicant seeking approval of a new game or game variation to pay the costs of the ensuing investigation; to amend regulation to require field trials of game variations; to amend regulations to require the manufacturer seeking approval of associated equipment to pay the cost of any ensuing inspection and investigation; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

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1. **CONSIDERATION OF:** Proposed revision of the **STATE GAMING CONTROL BOARD PERSONNEL MANUAL** pursuant to NRS 463.080(6) and NGC Regulation 2.110(4). The State Gaming Control Board Personnel Manual ("Manual") is a comprehensive plan governing employment and retention or discharge of employees to assure that termination or other adverse action is not taken against such employees except for cause, and provisions for hearings in personnel matters and for review of adverse actions taken in such matters. The Manual governs all State Gaming Control Board ("Board") and Nevada Gaming Commission ("Commission") unclassified employees in all employment and personnel administration matters. Additionally, the Manual governs Board classified employees in employment termination matters and specific conduct, prohibitions, conditions, and particular expectations necessitated by the nature of the duties and responsibilities of the Board and Commission.

Digest of Revisions:

**Subsections 5, 6, and 7 of Section I(B)** add that the Manual takes precedence over all directives and division procedures; the Board Chairman is responsible for the interpretation of the Manual, and has the discretion to set policy concerning any employment and personnel administration matters upon which the Manual is silent; the Personnel Office is responsible for the administration of the Manual under the direction of the Chief of Administration; and the provisions established and set forth concerning termination also apply to the Board's classified employees.

**Subsections 1 and 2 of Section I(C)** acknowledges the necessity for the Board to comply with all pertinent Federal and State provisions governing employment.

**Subsections 4 - 9 of Section III(E)** acknowledges that some employees of the Board are "non-exempt employees" whereas others are "exempt employees" under the terms of the Federal Labor Standards Act of 1938, and provides differences regarding compensation for overtime.

**Section III(F)** clarifies that longevity pay amounts are set by the Legislature and are implemented accordingly.

**Subsection 2 of Section III(G)** provides that employees who qualify for shift differential payment will be compensated for shift differential when on sick and annual leave, holidays, and other paid leave.

**Sections III(H)** provides that the Board will adopt a plan to authorize and make credential payments to qualifying employees in the fiscal years for which a Legislative appropriation has been made to fund such.

**Subsections 4 of Section IV(D)** adds that in addition to the hiring Division and the Chief of the Administration Division, the Board Chairman or his designee must also approve substitution of related experience, education, or other qualifications for the specific minimum qualification requirements for a position.

**Subsection 1(d) of Section IV(E)** adds that in addition to the Chief of the Administration Division, the Board Chairman must also approve filling a vacant position by involuntary demotion upon the recommendation of the pertinent Division Chief.

**Subsection 1(e) of Section IV(E)** adds that a recommendation of a Division Chief to fill a vacant position by temporary appointment of an individual to a position not to exceed six (6) months must be approved by the Chief of the Administration Division in addition to the Board Chairman.

**Subsection 1(f) of Section IV(E)** provides the circumstances under which a former employee who terminated their employment with the Board may be reinstated, and qualifies that the employee will be required to serve a new probationary period.

**Subsection 5 of Section IV(E)** adds that candidates for employment with the Board must pass a pre-employment drug test and are subject to random drug/alcohol testing as a condition of employment with the Board, and that certain Divisions and/or position classifications may also require a medical examination and physical fitness test following the offer of employment to a candidate.

**Subsection 6 of Section IV(E)** adds that the candidates for employment in positions that require carrying a firearm will also be required to pass a polygraph examination and take a psychological examination.

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**Subsection 2 of Section IV(F)** further clarifies what an examination for employment with the Board may comprise and adds that the examination contents and procedures will be determined and/or developed by the Personnel Office in cooperation with the hiring Division.

**Subsection 3 of Section IV(F)** adds that scoring sheets from employment examinations will be maintained by the hiring Division for three years.

**Subsections 3(c)(1) and (2) of Section IV(G)** add that all ties on Eligible Lists for divisional promotion are broken by seniority within the Division and all ties on Eligible Lists for departmental promotion are broken by seniority within the Board.

**Subsections 7(h), (i), (j), and (k) of Section IV(G)** add reasons that a candidate for employment may be removed from an Eligible List.

**Section IV(H)** adds provisions pertinent to the background investigations the Board's Professional Standards Office conducts on prospective employees of the agency.

**Section IV(I)** adds definitions for terms used in reference to provisions concerning "Employee Status."

**Subsection 1 of Section IV(I)** extends the probationary period for a person appointed to a position with the Board from one year to two years of fulltime employment.

**Subsection 2 of Section IV(I)** adds that advancement of an employee to permanent status must be approved by the Administration Division.

**Subsection 5 of Section IV(I)** adds that an employee transferring to an unclassified position in the Enforcement Division must successfully complete and meet all of the requirements for employment specific to that Division.

**Subsection 5 of Section IV(J)** adds that all appointments and promotions to positions above entry-level must be approved by the Chairman.

**Section IV(L)** clarifies provisions governing transfers of Board employees from one position to another in the agency.

**Section IV(M)** provides for unpaid internships to be offered by the Board.

**Subsection 3 of Section V(B)** clarifies work and leave reporting requirements of non-exempt and exempt Board employees.

**Subsection (5)(d) of Section V(C)** adds necessities to obtain prior approval before working overtime on paid holidays.

**Section V(D)** clarifies that employees are required to obtain approval prior to taking annual leave, and specifies that an employee does not accrue annual leave when on leave without pay. It also provides that leave is to be managed so individual employees do not have to use large amounts of accrued leave at year-end to avoid losing it.

**Section V(E)** clarifies that use of sick leave may be approved only after it has been ascertained that the absence was for an authorized/legitimate reason, and adds that substantiating evidence may be required to be produced when sick leave exceeds three consecutive days or in cases of apparent abuse. It also adds that, in cases of use of family sick leave, documentation identifying the immediate family member and the nature of their illness must be provided by the employee.

**Subsection 2 of Section V(E)** provides for exception to the 120-hour limitation regarding use of family sick leave, and for waiver of requirements relative to residency in the employee's household.

**Section V(F)** adds provisions governing catastrophic leave.

**Subsections 3 – 7 of Section V(G)** add provisions concerning *Voluntary Leave Without Pay*.

**Subsections 5, 6, and 7 of Section V(H)** add provisions concerning *Miscellaneous Leaves of Absence With Pay*.

**REGULATION AGENDA  
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**Subsection 8 of Section V(H)** provides that the Board Chairman may grant administrative leave with or without pay for any cause the Chairman deems appropriate.

**Subsections 1 of Section VI(C)** adds that probationary employees will receive an evaluation at the two-year mark of being hired by the Board, in addition to receiving evaluations after being employed for six months and one year.

**Subsections 4 of Section VI(C)** adds that employees compensated at the maximum of the salary range for the classification of their position, and who have had at least two evaluations in their current position, will be evaluated at the discretion of the Chief of their respective Division. Also, absent the issuance of subsequent evaluations, employees will be considered to be performing at the level of their last rating. Employees, however, may request a formal evaluation at any time.

**Subsections 6 of Section VI(C)** clarifies that the Personnel Office provides or approves the performance evaluation methodology used in evaluating Board employees.

**Subsections 3 of Section VII(A)** specifies that the Board reserves the right, at all times, and without prior notice, to inspect and search any and all Board property for the purpose of ensuring legitimate business interests and obligations of the Board are being met, gives examples of what constitutes "Board property," and provides that inspections may be conducted before, during or after business hours and in the presence or absence of the employee.

**Subsections 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 9, 10, 14, 18, 19, 21, 22, and 23 of Section VII(B)** clarify, identify, or add specific conduct, responsibilities, conditions, and prohibitions that pertain to Board employees.

**Section VIII(B)** adds definitions for terms used in reference to provisions concerning "Causes for Disciplinary Action."

**Section VIII(C)** identifies grounds for immediate termination of employment regarding classified and unclassified employees.

**Subsections 1 – 7, 9, 16, 17, 22, 24, 25, 28, and 30 of Section VIII(D)** clarify or identify grounds for administering disciplinary action.

**Section VIII(E)** provides for the reporting and consequences of an employee who is convicted of driving under the influence, or an offense involving driving under the influence, while either driving a privately owned vehicle on State business or a State vehicle.

**Subsections 1 and 2 of Section IX(A)** clarify rights of Board employees who become the subject of an internal investigation that could result in disciplinary action.

**Subsection 5 of Section IX(A)** provides reporting requirements with respect to when allegations concerning potentially serious or complex misconduct issues outside the scope of the standard operational and managerial functions become known.

**Subsection 7(b) of Section IX(A)** clarifies that an exempt employee is not subject to disciplinary suspensions for less than (1) one full workweek, except in situations involving sexual harassment.

**Subsection 7 of Section IX(A)** provides that the Attorney General must be consulted prior to imposition of any disciplinary action involving suspension, reduction in pay, demotion, or termination of an employee.

**Subsection 8(e) of Section IX(A)** provides, relative to an employee's right to respond in writing to a notice received specifying disciplinary action against the employee, the consequences of the employee not submitting a written response and the potential outcomes of submitting a response.

**Section IX(B)** identifies the procedures for administering disciplinary actions relative to Board employees in the classified service.

**Subsection 2 of Section IX(C)** adds that when an unclassified employee appeals a disciplinary action, the Board Chairman may direct the Personnel Office to attempt to facilitate a resolution of the issue appealed.

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**Subsection 3 of Section IX(C)** adds that reasonable accommodation will be provided in a hearing involving appeal of a disciplinary action to a party with a disability.

**Subsection 5 of Section IX(C)** adds that the hearing officer in a hearing involving appeal of a disciplinary action by an unclassified employee may exclude or limit the number of witnesses.

**Section IX(C)** clarifies that unclassified employees may not be afforded administrative leave to work on their appeals of disciplinary actions during work hours.

**Section IX(D)** identifies the procedures for administrative review of disciplinary actions concerning classified employees.

**Section X(C)** provides that employees may not be granted administrative leave to work on their grievances during working hours, and clarifies that reasonable accommodation will be provided in the grievance process to a party with a disability.

**Subsection 1 of Section X(D)** adds that if the individual assisting/representing an employee in the grievance process is, himself/herself, a state employee, he/she may only assist on his/her own time.

**Section XI(C)** adds provisions governing reductions in unclassified staff.

**Section XI(D)** provides for exit interview of employees separating from Board service.

**Subsection 5 and 6 of Section XII(B)** identify retention and maintenance provisions governing employee personnel records/files.

**Section XII(C)** identifies collection and retention provisions governing employee background investigation files.

**Subsections 1, 3, 4, and 5 of Section XII(F)** clarify or identify personnel record retention schedules.

**Section XII(G)** adds provisions governing the removal of records.
