**Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections**

**Win Revenue Summary – April 2015**

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$897,925,088 for the month of April 2015. This amounts to a 5.39% increase compared to April 2014, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$851,977,865. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2014 through April 30, 2015), gaming win has decreased 1.44%.

**Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of May 2015**

The State collected \$53,445,133 in percentage fees during the month of May 2015\*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in April 2015. This represents an 11.58% (or \$5,547,151) increase compared to the prior year's May, when percentage fee collections were \$47,897,982.
