SUBJECT: THE REGISTRATION OF ARMED SECURITY PERSONNEL

The Nevada Gaming Control Board's Enforcement Division announces the following changes, which take effect immediately. The changes relate to the registration of armed security personnel as detailed in Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 5.102.

Due to recent changes by the Nevada Department of Public Safety, a registered gaming employee must now meet one of the following criteria to be approved for an <u>armed</u> security position:

- Hold a current concealed weapon permit issued by a political subdivision of the State of Nevada;
- Hold a current armed work credential issued by a political subdivision of the State of Nevada;
- Be presently employed as an active duty law enforcement officer in the State of Nevada:
- Be a retired law enforcement officer who holds a current Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act card;
- Be presently registered as a gaming employee in an armed security personnel position with another licensee; or
- Submit a renewal of registration as a gaming employee in an armed security personnel position;

If an applicant meets any of the above criteria, please send a copy of the applicable credential to eru@gcb.nv.gov with special attention to the Background Investigations Unit. If an application was recently submitted and does not meet one of the above criteria, the Employee

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Registration Unit will notify the responsible licensee and applicant by letter stating that the application is incomplete based on the above requirements.
