Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – January 2022

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,078,761,266 for the month of January 2022. This amounts to a 41.58% <u>increase</u> compared to January 2021, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$761,919,236. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2021 through January 31, 2022), gaming win has increased 57.76%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of February 2022

The State collected \$81,223,263 in percentage fees during the month of February 2022*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in January 2022. This represents a 75.47% (or \$34,934,173) increase compared to the prior year's February, when percentage fee collections were \$46,289,090.
