Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – October 2022

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$1,280,704,342 for the month of October 2022. This amounts to a 4.83% increase compared to October 2021, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,221,749,941. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2022 through October 31, 2022), gaming win has increased 3.02%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of November 2022

The State collected \$76,420,992 in percentage fees during the month of November 2022*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in October 2022. This represents a 6.42% (or \$4,608,691) increase compared to the prior year's November, when percentage fee collections were \$71,812,301.
