Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – December 2024

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$1,461,092,483 for the month of December 2024. This amounts to a 2.0% increase compared to December 2023 when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,432,458,568. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024), gaming win has decreased 1.98%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of January 2025

The State collected \$90,501,824 in percentage fees during the month of January 2025*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in December 2024. This represents a 6.56% (or \$5,574,458) increase compared to the prior year’s January, when percentage fee collections were \$84,927,366.
