Win Revenue Summary – April 2017

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$886,528,810 for the month of April 2017. This amounts to a 1.19% <u>increase</u> compared to April 2016, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$876,135,199. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2016 through April 30, 2017), gaming win has increased 3.03%.

The State collected \$44,245,090 in percentage fees during the month of May 2017*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in April 2017. This represents a 0.26% (or \$116,405) increase compared to the prior year's May, when percentage fee collections were \$44,128,685.
