## Win Revenue Summary - April 2019

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$936,478,914 for the month of April 2019. This amounts to a $1.81 \%$ decrease compared to April 2018, when licensees reported a gaming win of $\$ 953,738,992$. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019), gaming win has increased $0.50 \%$.

## Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of May 2019

The State collected $\mathbf{\$ 5 0 , 9 2 0 , 4 2 2}$ in percentage fees during the month of May $2019 *$, based upon the taxable revenues generated in April 2019. This represents a $5.11 \%$ (or $\$ 2,740,338$ ) decrease compared to the prior year's May, when percentage fee collections were $\mathbf{\$ 5 3 , 6 6 0 , 7 6 0}$.
