Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – August 2007

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,016,465,602 for the month of August 2007. This amounts to a 4.41% <u>decrease</u> compared to August 2006, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,063,346,600. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2007 through August 31, 2007), gaming win has increased 2.84%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of September 2007

The State collected \$58,141,148 in percentage fees during the month of September 2007, based upon the taxable revenues generated in August 2007. This represents a 13.24% (or \$8,871,242) decrease compared to the prior year's September, when percentage fee collections were \$67,012,390.
