### **Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections**

#### Win Revenue Summary – August 2018

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of **912,980,589** for the month of August 2018. This amounts to a **7.74% decrease** compared to August 2017, when licensees reported a gaming win of **\$989,526,639**. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2018 through August 31, 2018), gaming win has decreased **3.99%**.

**Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of September 2018**

The State collected \$46,801,433 in percentage fees during the month of September 2018\*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in August 2018. This represents a 7.02% (or \$3,532,921) decrease compared to the prior year's September, when percentage fee collections were \$50,334,354.
