December 2007 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – December 2007

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,095,421,697 for the month of December 2007. This amounts to a 3.06% increase compared to December 2006, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,062,941,263. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2007 through December 31, 2007), gaming win has increased 1.73%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of January 2008

The State collected \$46,350,240 in percentage fees during the month of January 2008, based upon the taxable revenues generated in December 2007. This represents a 9.37% (or \$4,793,507) decrease compared to the prior year's January, when percentage fee collections were \$51,143,747.
