Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – February 2012

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$932,173,138 for the month of February 2012. This amounts to a 5.72% increase compared to February 2011, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$881,758,357. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2011 through February 29, 2012), gaming win has increased 3.95%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of March 2012

The State collected \$70,354,087 in percentage fees during the month of March 2012, based upon the taxable revenues generated in February 2012. This represents a 69.24% (or \$28,783,354) increase compared to the prior year's March, when percentage fee collections were \$41,570,733.
