February 2017 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – February 2017

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$945,597,573 for the month of February 2017. This amounts to a 4.48% <u>decrease</u> compared to February 2016, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$989,909,589. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017), gaming win has increased 2.71%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of March 2017

The State collected \$51,986,240 in percentage fees during the month of March 2017*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in February 2017. This represents a 2.87% (or \$1,449,263) increase compared to the prior year's March, when percentage fee collections were \$50,536,977.
