Win Revenue Summary – January 2017

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,036,265,398 for the month of January 2017. This amounts to a 12.02% <u>increase</u> compared to January 2016, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$925,066,268. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2016 through January 31, 2017), gaming win has increased 3.81%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of February 2017

The State collected \$75,211,531 in percentage fees during the month of February 2017*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in January 2017. This represents an 8.08% (or \$6,609,453) decrease compared to the prior year's February, when percentage fee collections were \$81,820,984.
