## Win Revenue Summary – January 2018

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,015,027,320 for the month of January 2018. This amounts to a 2.05% <u>decrease</u> compared to January 2017, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,036,217,995. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2017 through January 31, 2018), gaming win has increased 1.56%.

## Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of February 2018

The State collected \$68,641,997 in percentage fees during the month of February 2018\*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in January 2018. This represents an 8.74% (or \$6,577,259) decrease compared to the prior year's February, when percentage fee collections were \$75,219,256.
