January 2021 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – January 2021

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$761,847,813 for the month of January 2021. This amounts to a 26.58% <u>decrease</u> compared to January 2020, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,037,679,865. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021), gaming win has decreased 24.41%.

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Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of February 2021

The State collected \$46,285,795 in percentage fees during the month of February 2021*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in January 2021. This represents a 36.62% (or \$26,740,330) decrease compared to the prior year's February, when percentage fee collections were \$73,026,125.
