Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – June 2018

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$933,003,709 for the month of June 2018. This amounts to a 4.17% <u>increase</u> compared to June 2017, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$895,695,131. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018), gaming win has increased 3.21%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of July 2018

The State collected \$47,410,727 in percentage fees during the month of July 2018*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in June 2018. This represents a 9.36% (or \$4,898,062) decrease compared to the prior year's July, when percentage fee collections were \$52,308,789.
