March 2017 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – March 2017

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$991,023,123 for the month of March 2017. This amounts to a 7.45% <u>increase</u> compared to March 2016, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$922,329,184. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2016 through March 31, 2017), gaming win has increased 3.23%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of April 2017

The State collected \$80,538,273 in percentage fees during the month of April 2017*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in March 2017. This represents a 10.41% (or \$7,593,070) increase compared to the prior year's April, when percentage fee collections were \$72,945,203.
