### **Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections**

#### Win Revenue Summary – May 2020

Nevada’s nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total “gaming win” of \$5,808,507 for the month of May 2020. This amounts to a 99.41% decrease compared to May 2019, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$981,766,859. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020), gaming win has decreased 19.38%.

**Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of June 2020**

The State collected \$56,003 in percentage fees during the month of June 2020\*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in May 2020. This represents a 99.91% (or \$59,154,720) decrease compared to the prior year's June, when percentage fee collections were \$59,210,723.
