November 2002 **Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections**

Overview

Gaming tax collections through the first six months of fiscal year 2003 are \$21.2 million behind the Economic Forum's Projection. The state budget by statute is built by using the Forum's projections. December's gaming tax collections (gaming win through November 2002) alone increased the shortfall for fiscal year 2003 by \$3.6 million.

"The news is bleak when you consider we fell another \$3.6 million behind where the economic forum projects us to be this month," Gov. Kenny Guinn said. "We need to be growing by nearly 18 percent per month in order to get caught up to the economic forum's projection. Obviously, that is just not realistic."

The September 11th terrorist attacks sharply curtailed travel to Nevada, skewing regular year-toyear comparisons of gaming revenue. Therefore, a more valid measurement is to compare November 2002 win revenue to November 2000. The state collected \$37.7 million in gaming tax revenue during the month of December 2002, based upon the taxable revenues generated in November 2002. The current gaming revenue tax is \$3.7 million less than was collected in December 2000.

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Win Revenue Summary – November 2002

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$732,485,227 for the month of November 2002. This amounts to a 1.53% <u>increase</u> compared to November 2001, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$721,467,523.

Percentage Fee Tax Collections for the Month of December 2002

The State collected \$37,691,278 in percentage fee taxes during the month of December 2002, based upon the taxable revenues generated in November 2002. This represents a 0.53% (or \$197,543) <u>increase</u> compared to the prior year's December (2001), when percentage fee collections were \$37,493,735.

On a six-month fiscal-year-to-date (July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002), the State of Nevada collected \$270,286,050 in percentage fee taxes. This represents a 2.22% <u>increase</u> from the prior fiscal year six-month period when collections totaled \$264,405,393.
