# November 2012 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

### Win Revenue Summary – November 2012

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$782,626,620 for the month of November 2012. This amounts to an 11.08% <u>decrease</u> compared to November 2011, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$880,127,660. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2012 through November 30, 2012), gaming win has increased 1.51%.

## Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of December 2012

The State collected \$45,747,843 in percentage fees during the month of December 2012, based upon the taxable revenues generated in November 2012. This represents a 20.21% (or \$11,586,646) decrease compared to the prior year's December, when percentage fee collections were \$57,334,489.
