October 2017 Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – October 2017

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$988,744,450 for the month of October 2017. This amounts to a 0.27% <u>increase</u> compared to October 2016, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$986,075,384. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2017 through October 31, 2017), gaming win has increased 3.76%.

The State collected \$59,688,436 in percentage fees during the month of November 2017*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in October 2017. This represents a 0.13% (or \$78,896) increase compared to the prior year's November, when percentage fee collections were \$59,609,540.
