Nevada Gaming Revenues and Collections

Win Revenue Summary – October 2019

Nevada's nonrestricted gaming licensees reported a total "gaming win" of \$1,021,909,865 for the month of October 2019. This amounts to a 3.85% <u>decrease</u> compared to October 2018, when licensees reported a gaming win of \$1,062,880,161. For the fiscal year (July 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019), gaming win has increased 2.47%.

Percentage Fee Collections for the Month of November 2019

The State collected \$62,333,010 in percentage fees during the month of November 2019*, based upon the taxable revenues generated in October 2019. This represents a 9.41% (or \$5,361,618) increase compared to the prior year's November, when percentage fee collections were \$56,971,392.
