Ngc board comments August 7---2024

Topic: Regulation 14.310----retention of records

- This regulation allows written records be destroyed after 5 years.
- I ask that this be changed----and that all records be retained indefinitely.
- Modification to gaming devices---are why casino games are fraudulent.
- Therefore, there should always be a record of the specific modifications made to these devices---for future references.
- Modifications allow casinos to control the outcome of the games----in both directions.
  - They can cause people to lose more often than usual---or
  - They can allow people to win---more often than usual.
- Allowing people to win-----is the most treacherous and manipulative aspect of casinos controlling the outcome------of the games.

Good morning. Aira Duyanen for the Culinary Union.

Just a quick note on our correspondence with the Tax and License Division regarding potential NGC Regulation 9 violations related to death of Mr. Lalji, a gaming license holder at Rampart Casino.

We received a letter on June 6 as promised by the Chair, and thank them for that.

We sent a follow up letter around July 22.

On August 2, the chief of the division gave us a status check and said that a response is being prepared.

We thank the Board and the staff for their time and attention on this.

But we have to ask again.

The question remains whether for almost four years Nevada gaming regulators did not know that a gaming license holder of a company behind a casino resort in the Las Vegas locals market was dead.

Was this the fault of Mr. Lalji's representatives in the Rampart Casino holding company, the fault of our state gaming regulators, or both?

And given that according to the June 6 letter the Nevada Gaming Commission has yet to approve a successor license holder for Rampart Casino, we also have to ask: have any profits from the gaming operation at the Rampart been paid to unlicensed heirs or family members of Mr. Lalji after his passing?

1ST PUBLIC COMMENT - ATTACHMENT 2 AUGUST 7, 2024

My name is Christopher Meng. I'm from Red Rock Casino. I work at the Lucky Penny Restaurant as a line cook. I have been working at Red Rock Casino for the past 7 years. I'm fighting for a union contract at Red Rock Casino for better pay, better working conditions, and job security.

Thank you.

Good morning. Zachary Poppel for the Culinary Union. There is a reason why Station Casinos employees chose to be represented by the Culinary Union. There is a reason why thousands of Station Casinos employees unionized between 2016 and 2019.

The Chief Legal Officer and Chief Financial Officer for Station Casinos are before the board today. They are among the highest-ranking executives in the company. In the Fall of 2019, Mr. Welch reviewed a slideshow deck presented to executives about a weaponized employee benefit scheme.

I want to offer excerpts from a June 2024 federal ruling by the National Labor Relations Board, a ruling which Station Casinos continues to litigate on appeal. In June 2024, on page 3, the NLRB wrote that: "We specifically affirm the judge's credibility resolutions in this respect and accordingly conclude that the Respondent did not establish that it decided to improve employee benefits for legitimate business reasons unrelated to the Union's campaign." In a footnote the ruling states: "Our careful review of the entire record reveals that many of the Respondent's witnesses, including Red Rock General Manager Scott Nelson, Station Casinos Chief Operating Officer Robert Finch, Executive Vice President and Chief Legal Officer Jeffrey Welch, Chief Financial Officer Stephen Cootey, and Senior Vice President for Human Resources Phil Fortino testified with such an unusual degree of evasiveness and wholly implausible forgetfulness that the judge was fully warranted in discounting their testimony as generally unreliable except where independently corroborated or against the Respondent's interest." The June 2024 ruling on page 7 and 8 reads: "The centerpiece of the Respondent's unlawful campaign was its tripart message promising and granting employees tremendous new benefits without the Union, threatening to withhold or withdraw these benefits if employees selected

the Union, and implicitly threatening that selecting the Union could only lead to years of fruitless bargaining without any improvement to working conditions. This highly coercive combination of promises and threats was accompanied by a barrage of further unlawful conduct, including additional threats that selecting the Union would lead to withdrawal of "favors," "extras," or "help" that employees could otherwise expect from management, implicit threats of job loss related to strikes, and interrogation and discriminatory treatment of Union supporters. The coercive impact of these unfair labor practices was magnified because they were committed by the Respondent's highest-ranking executives, including Red Rock General Manager Nelson and Station Casinos Senior Vice President for Human Resources Fortino, as well as other managers and supervisors at all levels."

We urge that Board to convey to Mr. Welch and Mr. Cootey today that in any future testimony under oath they be less evasive and forgetful. The Chief Legal Officer and the Chief Financial Officer of a Nevada Gaming company should be trustworthy and credible witnesses in law enforcement proceedings.

Good morning. Rory Kuykendall for the Culinary Union. I want to provide two updates about Station Casinos and request the Board and Commission assign a staff person to monitor ongoing legal proceedings and examine for exhibits potential violations of Nevada gaming law.

The first update is that in the United States Court of Appeals for the DC Circuit, the National Labor Relations Board has moved for enforcement of its June 17 order against Red Rock Casino. Red Rock Casino has asked for review. The case numbers are 24-1221, 24-1239, and 24-1240. If the Court sides with the NLRB and workers, then the Board's order of June 17, 2024 requiring Red Rock Casino to recognize and bargain with the union will be enforced. As a reminder, the NLRB's June 17 order ruled that Red Rock Casino's "extensive coercive and unlawful misconduct" between September 2019 and June 2020 "stemmed from a carefully crafted corporate strategy" and that "the most important unfair labor practices were planned and executed by Red Rock Casino and Station Casinos' top management and owners."

The second update is that down the street last week, one of the largest labor law enforcement actions in history resumed. NLRB prosecutors and attorneys for Station Casinos made opening arguments, and the General Manager for Red Rock Casino was called to the stand.

We will keep you updated on both of these legal proceedings. Our request today is that you direct a staff person to monitor ongoing legal proceedings who can apprise you of issues that may bear upon your duty to determine the ongoing suitability of officers and employees who engaged in the administration or supervision of the activities of a corporate gaming licensee, including the ability of such persons to testify truthfully under oath. The hearings here in Vegas are open to the public.

We are here today to ask you for an answer to the following question: Is it acceptable to the Gaming Control Board and Commission that top executives of a Nevada gaming company should testify under oath in a federal proceeding "with such an unusual degree of evasiveness and wholly implausible forgetfulness" that a judge is "fully warranted in discounting their testimony as generally unreliable except where independently corroborated or against the Respondent's interest?" That is what the National Labor Relations Board found of Mr. Welch, Mr. Cootey, and others just this past June. As the guardians of the integrity of the Nevada Gaming Industry, what do you intend to do about it?
