DIVISION REPORT

This item is placed on the agenda to allow the various divisions of the Nevada Gaming Control Board the opportunity to update the public regarding matters relevant to the respective division. A different division will provide an update each month. This month's division is:

PUBLIC COMMENTS

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PUBLIC COMMENTS AND DISCUSSION:

Comments taken from Member Assad in gratitude of the Investigations Division. Chair Hendrick echoed Member Assad's comments, and thanked his daughter for the tie he wore today.

Good morning and happy New Year to you all. My name is Diamante Asberry, and I'm here on behalf of the Culinary Union.

Culinary Union members just won a record breaking contract. The Culinary Union's new contract at 23+ properties on the Strip guarantees \$9.21 in an economic package increase over five years.

Every worker will be getting a 10% wage increase in the first year retroactive to June 2023 and a total of 32% in raises over the life of the new contract.

Culinary Union members on the Strip have once again fought and won a first-class standard for themselves and their families.

Meanwhile, Station Casinos workers are still being treated like second-class workers.

Station Casinos does not provide benefits equally to all workers—providing some employees benefits about life, death, and money while denying the same benefits to other employees. Station Casinos could have stopped its discrimination against workers any day in 2023, but they refused. Over the course of workers unionizing and fighting discrimination, Station Casinos has implemented enhanced benefits because workers have stood up, organized, and demanded better.

Station Casinos management created MUD lists, tracking which workers were pro-management, pro-union, or "don't know." Station Casinos property directors used these MUD lists to decide which workers to rehire during the pandemic. These MUD Lists caused damage to Stations workers and their families.

Workers at Station Casinos properties voted for the union and won elections by large margins despite the company fighting their organizing efforts. These workers are *still* fighting for the company to respect their voices and bargain a fair collective bargaining agreement with the Culinary Union.

Station Casinos workers deserve first-class standards like other hospitality workers throughout the city. They deserve dignity and respect.

Hello, my name is Kathleen Penna, I'm a cocktail server at Red Rock Casino.

I started working with Station casinos in 1997, opening with Sunset Station as a cocktail server.

In the 9 years working at Sunset, we had three rebids. Three opportunities to change our hours, days off, and our entire shift to better suit our lives.

I transferred to open the Red Rock Casino in 2006 to be closer to my home, so I wouldn't have to drive 27 miles one way. I opened Red Rock cocktailing in the bingo room. I remember that we were told by our hiring manager in a few years we would have a rebid and get to change our shifts.

After several years there was a rebid. Only the bartenders and the slot cocktail servers were included.

While the bartenders' classifications were abolished, many of the cocktail servers were stuck in these classifications. Meaning no movement for any cocktail server other than slots. Bingo, poker, race and sports, and the pit were not allowed to bid anywhere.

I was not given any reason why bartenders were able to leave the classifications and cocktail servers were not. I went through the proper channels of my beverage department, human resources, the General manager, and corporate, and no one could or would give me a reason why we were all stuck in these classifications and not allowed to bid anywhere else.

Now it is going on 18 years and I am in the same position: same days off with the same hours. My children were in elementary school when I started at Red Rock. My husband and I worked opposite schedules, so one of us would be home at all times for our girls. Now our girls are adults. For me to change my schedule at all, I have to take a massive pay cut or work graveyard to get out of this classification.

I have worked for Station Casinos for nearly 28 years, and I feel that no one is listening. We are now a union property and have been fighting for a fair contract. But again, no one from Stations is listening to our voices.

I only hope someone is listening now.

Hello everyone.

My name is Dan Serwinowski. I wanted to tell you a little bit about my story. I had been a banquet server at Red Rock Casino for 14 years before the pandemic. I started out as an on-call banquet server and worked very hard working my way up to full-time A-list. I knew this was where I wanted to be full time, so I turned down opportunities at other casinos for that reason.

Because I was full-time at Red Rock, I had an opportunity to sign a contract for a new construction home. They started to build my home in January 2020. In March 2020 the pandemic hit, and Red Rock let me go and separated me from the company. Heartless, all because of pandemic!

I did not know what to do, so I continued on as if I was still going to be able to purchase the home. I watched my home being built from the ground up and worked with the superintendent to make sure everything that I had ordered was installed correctly. I devoted my time and effort to my dream. Then about a week before closing, the mortgage company went through my finances and concluded that I no longer qualified to purchase my dream home because I did not have a job. My only income was unemployment. I was devastated, depressed and disappointed because I lost my home. My American dream of owning a home was taken away from me, shattered.

A year later Red Rock hired me back, one day before the new SB386: Right to Return to work law went into effect. They rehired me as an on-call server, with no seniority. Before I was let go, I had been fighting for a union at Red Rock, wearing my union button at work and representing my coworkers.

During the time I was gone Red Rock decided to hire new employees and put them on the part-time list, a position above what I was rehired as. My 14 years of seniority meant nothing to them. I was like dirt tossed to the curb.

Red Rock and Stations talk about how they're one of the only casino companies that paid their workers throughout the pandemic. I also work at The Wynn and their union employees were never let go and had been paid almost their full wages, including gratuity, throughout the pandemic, according to the amount of hours we worked two months prior. That's the union difference.

I had represented my coworkers at Red Rock since October 2018. I knew back then that we needed a union contract at Red Rock to protect our jobs with dignity and respect.

What has happened to me has only made me want to fight even harder for a union contract with job security so they will never be able to do this again to anyone.
