Gaming regulation 12.1000-----other instrumentalities

- This regulation is the most **unusual---vague—and broad** reaching regulation of all the regulations.
- It is ----**hidden**---in the regulation about chips and tokens---but it is not a chip or a token.
- The term **instrumentality**----is defined as---anything used in gaming.
- It allows the chairman----**alone**---to approve the design and all specifications used in this instrumentality-----without written documentation of any kind.
- **In other words**---this one regulation-----**bypasses** -----all other regulations in the entire book of regulations.
- The term **Instrumentalities**----with which gaming is conducted-----could mean anything and everything.
- The one instrumentality that I think it is referring to -----are the “**so called**” shuffling machines used in **blackjack, baccarat** and other card games.
- These -----“**so called**” shuffling machines-----can arrange the cards in any sequence they choose. Their own internet marketing----used this as a selling point.
- Some of these machines have over **100 different “shuffling”** settings.
- Since there is only one way to randomly shuffle cards-----the other 99 are apparently for **arranging** the cards---what other explanation is there?
- By observing the distribution of the cards as they are dealt----it is obvious that they are not random.
- A previous chairman approved these—instrumentalities----but we don’t know who, because there is no written documentation.
- Today's chairman----can withdraw this approval----which I hope you will do.

Good morning. Zachary Poppel for the Culinary Union.

On July 29 counsel for Station Casinos filed a statement of issues to be raised in the U.S Court of Appeals DC Circuit. The filing shows Stations Casinos' company is rolling the dice in federal court to see if they can fundamentally restructure labor law enforcement in our country by challenging the constitutionality of the National Labor Relations Board. According to Station Casinos, the system of federal law enforcement and its judges that hold Station Casinos accountable somehow violates their rights under the Constitution. This claim about the Constitution comes from a Nevada gaming company that violates federal labor law over and over again. In fact, the size and weight of Station Casinos violations have slowed down the NLRB and prevented a final legal reckoning in one of the largest labor law enforcement actions in US history.

We have a copy of their July 29 filing to turn in along with these comments.

We are concerned about what Station Casinos' challenge to the constitutionality of labor law enforcement means for Nevadans and the gaming industry. Nevada gaming industry workers have federal rights they depend on to win respect at work and to win better pay and benefits for their families. There is a law enforcement system that preserves the fundamental freedom to join a union. And now you have a large gaming employer arguing in federal court that that law enforcement system that preserves the fundamental freedom to join a union should not exist as it does at present.

Essential to that federal labor law enforcement system is telling the truth and nothing but the truth in law enforcement proceedings. And we again must restate the fact that the top of the NLRB found that top executives Station Casinos testified under oath in a federal proceeding "with such an unusual degree of evasiveness and wholly implausible forgetfulness" that a judge was "fully warranted in discounting their testimony as generally unreliable except where independently corroborated or against the Respondent's interest." At question was whether the Chief Operating Officer, the Chief Legal Officer, the Chief Financial Officer, the top labor strategy or HR executive, could provide credible testimony about

significant matters related to labor strategy and how they discussed that strategy with the owners of the company. In law enforcement proceedings gaming company executives need to give credible, truthful testimony about significant company strategies and need to give credible, truthful testimony about how owners engage in those strategies. No gaming company or its executives should have a problem with the truth and telling it.

There hearings next week in the labor law trial against Station Casinos. We again urge the Board to assign a staff person to monitor the proceedings in person, particularly when a gaming license holder is on the stand. Thanks.

**STATEMENT OF ISSUES TO
BE RAISED**

Pursuant to the Court’s June 27, 2024 Order, Petitioner/Cross-Respondent NP Red Rock LLC d/b/a Red Rock Casino Resort Spa (“Red Rock”) hereby states that it intends to raise the following issues on appeal:

1. Whether Respondent/Cross-Petitioner National Labor Relations Board (“NLRB”) properly found that Red Rock violated Section 8(a)(1) of the National Labor Relations Act (“NLRA”) by promising, announcing, and granting benefits in

order to dissuade employees from selecting Petitioner/Cross-Respondent Joint Executive Board of Las Vegas a/w UNITE HERE International Union (“the Union”).

2. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Section 8(a)(1) of the NLRA by threatening employees with the loss, withholding, and/or withdrawal of benefits, with the loss of favors, extras, relationships with supervisors, with the inevitability of a strike, and job loss as a result of a strike, and with unspecified reprisals if they select the Union, and by threatening employees that selecting the Union would be futile.

3. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Section 8(a)(1) of the NLRA by interrogating an employee about her union sympathies.

4. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Sections 8(a)(1) and (3) of the NLRA by issuing disciplinary warnings to an employee because of her support for and activities on behalf of the Union.

5. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Sections 8(a)(1) and (3) of the NLRA by issuing a discriminatory work assignment to an employee because of her support for and activities on behalf of the Union.

6. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Sections 8(a)(1) and (3) of the NLRA by failing to recall or reinstate an employee because of her support for and activities on behalf of the Union.

7. Whether the NLRB properly found that an affirmative bargaining order under *NLRB v. Gissel Packing Co.*, 395 U.S. 575 (1969), was warranted.

8. Whether the NLRB properly found that an affirmative bargaining order under *Cemex Construction Materials Pacific, LLC*, 372 N.L.R.B. No. 130 (2023), was warranted.

9. Whether the NLRB properly found that Red Rock violated Sections 8(a)(1) and (5) of the NLRA by failing to recognize and bargain with the Union, including by failing to offer the Union notice and an opportunity to bargain prior to cancelling table-swap agreements.

10. Whether the extraordinary remedies imposed by the NLRB are proper.

11. Whether the dual prosecutorial/adjudicative powers of the NLRB should have resulted in the recusal of two Board members from deciding the case.

12. Whether the NLRB's adjudication of private rights without a jury trial violated the Seventh Amendment.

13. Whether the NLRB's members and administrative law judges are unconstitutionally insulated from removal.

Hello. My name is Dan Serwinowski. I'm a banquet server at Red Rock spa resort Hotel. I started working there back in December 2006, about six months after they had opened. I started out as an on-call banquet server and enjoyed it so much I decided to move my way up from on-call to part-time to full-time A List. This was where I wanted to retire.

I always had aspirations of Red Rock becoming a union hotel so we could have fair wages, free medical care, a pension and other benefits. I decided to become a Red Rock committee leader with the Culinary Union to start organizing, which was our right.

With all of our hard work, including several picket lines, and dealing with Union busters, we were ready to vote to unionize. We had secured an election date of December 19, 2019.

Management told employees and used a flyer stating that they were having a mandatory captive audience meeting on December 16 and 17th, two days before the election to vote yes or no on the union. It was a mandatory meeting where according to the flyer we were a captive audience.

I attended one of these meetings. The company made announcements and promises about benefits. Top managers said that the benefits were only guaranteed if we rejected the union. Right away one thought I had was, how could they be doing this right before the election?.

I ask you today to please examine this company flyer and ask the company about it. Why would they hold mandatory captive audience meetings days before an election?

From 2006 to 2020 I served Red Rock with loyalty and dedication. I worked my way up to the A list. I had hopes and real plans and real savings for building a home. But in 2020, during COVID, management chose to separate me from the company and then I came back as an on-call server.

I wish the company had not held mandatory captive audience meetings for its own employees. And again I ask you to examine the flyer and ask the company about it.
