- (3) THE EXECUTED CLOSING DOCUMENTS FOR THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY AND ASSETS COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE RED GARTER HOTEL & CASINO MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE GCB WITHIN 10 DAYS AFTER CLOSING.
